of Blessed Families in and from the Ukraine

Miraculous evacuation from Bucha Town Basement

On 10 March, after several failed attempts, two blessed families were successfully evacuated from the township of Bucha, near Kyiv. They had spent much of the time living in the basement with their young children, including a two-month-old baby girl.

Miraculously, after boarding the first of several buses, the blessed families discovered that theirs was the only bus allowed to leave for Kyiv train station. Kyiv News highlighted the plight of the 2-month-old baby.

On 14 March an apartment block (right) in Kyiv was destroyed by Russian missiles. This is where the current national leader and her family had lived with two other families from 2012 to 2016.

Since the beginning of the war on 24 February 2022 almost all of the blessed wives and children have left the danger zones and moved to western Ukraine and/or to other countries.

Seven families and 10 young members moved to Poland, eight to Germany, three to Lithuania, one family each to Austria and Turkey. More will be moving abroad in the coming days. Two more families are scheduled to arrive in the Peace Embassy in Budapest.
