Dear Families,

Registration is now open for members who would like to join the planned Hyojeong Pilgrimage to Korea for the dedication of the Cheonwongung, and surrounding ceremonies. Space is limited, so we urge immediate registration at our dedicated website <u>korea2023.familyfed.eu</u>

I would like everyone that is going to Korea for the events to take a moment to ensure that they are wellprepared to experience all that True Parents are arranging - both internally and externally. Although many dedications have taken place in the past, this will be the only time that the Cheon Won Gung and the Cheon II Sanctum, Heavenly Parent's Holy Temple, will be dedicated. So, I would like to invite those that will be in Korea for the May events to offer some extra devotion in preparation:

I propose that each person that is going to Korea for the events pays a portion of their registration fee from their own funds - even if some or all of the rest of the costs for accommodation and flights are or will be supported by their community or nation.

I originally suggested that the required initial deposit of 100 EUR could be the minimum suggested personal contribution. However, I am aware that each person may have different financial circumstances - 100 EUR may not be that much for some people, but for others, it is a large sum. Therefore, each individual can determine by themselves how much to personally contribute as a condition of devotion for internal preparation.

In addition to that, I would like to remind everyone that each individual that coming should make or have made a Cheon Won Gung Donation

And finally, everyone should join the 40-day regional condition to receive Special Grace.

I would like to note that, as any conditional offering should be, all these are optional and a matter of personal decision and responsibility. Let us all reflect on how we are preparing ourselves for this occasion and ensuring that we can get as much out of the experience as possible.



Here are the recommended dates to arrive and depart from South Korea.

- Package 1: 3-9 May
- Package 2: 3-10 May
- Package 3: 3-12 May

Note:

- Be sure to arrive in Korea no later than 3rd May. If you come before 3rd May, you may have to pay extra or arrange your own accommodation.
 - IMPORTANT: To attend the YSP Assembly on 2nd May, you should arrive in Korea by May 1st. If you will attend the YSP Assembly, please ensure your flight arrives in Korea by latest May 1st.
 - Participants are encouraged to enquire with their community/nation regarding financial support for flight tickets
