More than 100 participants from across Europe embarked on the transformative Hyojeong Youth Pilgrimage. With an average age of 21, the majority of these attendees set foot in South Korea for the very first time.

Over the course of three intense weeks, participants engaged in a diverse array of activities, including enlightening lectures, moments of introspection, and team-building exercises.

This immersive experience left each attendee feeling a more profound connection with True Parents, a strengthened bond with fellow participants, and a resounding endorsement of the pilgrimage to others seeking a similar transformative journey.

(1) I am grateful for a spiritually and physically demanding, but also reflective and rejuvenating time. It's not always so easy to take some time to take a break and to live your life of faith so intensively, which was very needed for me, I think.

I'm really grateful for the people that participated on the pilgrimage with me, it's always a bit challenging but also so nice and refreshing to be with so many people from different countries and backgrounds, which helped me personally to see things I need to work on from a different perspective.

God answered me that I should learn to be a true filial daughter who can take responsibility for others, become an elder sister and always have the heart to give love.
