The Final 40-Day Devotion Before the Entrance Ceremony!

Just a couple of hours ago, we received an urgent message from the World Mission Headquarters informing us that we would join a final 40-day period of devotion before the entrance ceremony for the Cheonwongung, which will start today. That memo from Korea has already been sent out and is also copied below for convenience.

Of course, the short notice is very unfortunate. Nevertheless, almost all members are already in the midst of devotional preparation for this tremendous providential event. We started a 160-day condition (4 x 40 days) more than 4 months ago, and indeed, we all have our minds focused clearly on the events in April. So, let's do our best and unite with this latest guidance.

You will notice THREE offerings to make during this time and THREE prayer points.

The three offerings are:

- 1) Prayer for the three specified prayer points
- 2) Participate in the Cheonshim Won Special Night Vigil (as often as possible)
- 3) Viewing the six lecture videos on the "Epic History of the Chosen Han People of Korea"

The Korean Epic will inform many aspects of the Entrance Ceremony. During our pilgrimage, we will visit a display in the Cheonwongung, and the victory celebration will include a musical version of the epic. Familiarizing ourselves with its contents will significantly help us understand and prepare.

Next, there are the THREE points of prayer. Let's say additional points of prayer.

- 1) To achieve oneness with Holy Mother Han, our True Mother.
- 2) For a victorious Entrance into the Cheon Won Gung Cheonil Sanctum
- 3) For the Heavenly United States to fulfil its responsibility to all of humankind as the providential eldest son nation. Let's go out on a limb and add to this a prayer for EUME and each of our own nations!
