## 13 years on, Sun Myung Moon's followers gather at large memorial event to pray for a new era of peace

Various media outlets in South Korea reported on 6th September on a large rally in Gapyeong, South Korea. The <u>Family Federation for World Peace and Unification</u>, often referred to as the <u>Unification Church</u>, marked a solemn and significant event on September 5, with the commemoration of the 13th anniversary of the "Cosmic Seonghwa" (funeral) of its co-founder, Reverend <u>Sun Myung Moon</u>.

The memorial service, held at the Cheongshim Peace World Center in Gapyeong, Gyeonggi Province, drew more than 30,000 participants from across the globe - members from Korea, Japan, the United States, Europe, Asia, and beyond gathered to honor the legacy of the man they revere as the <u>True Parent</u> of Heaven, Earth, and Humankind. This level of international participation not only highlighted the continuing spiritual influence of <u>Reverend Moon</u> but also reflected the enduring global reach of the <u>Family Federation</u>'s vision.

The event was themed "Prayer Meeting for the Beginning of a New Era and New History Centered on Harmony and Peace", underscoring the <u>organization</u>'s dual commitment to personal faith and broader societal transformation. Through songs of praise, sermons, united prayers for reconciliation, and a special vigil devotional prayer for Korea's prosperity, participants were invited to reflect on their spiritual responsibilities while seeking renewed strength to contribute to peace in families, communities, and

Several speeches captured the spiritual and reformist tone of the gathering. <u>Doo Seung-Yeon</u>, Director of the World Mission Headquarters, emphasized the cumulative impact of small, faithful actions:

"When each of our small acts of practice come together to create a history of harmony and peace in families, churches, workplaces, and society, only then can we achieve the true goal. Let us forgive one another and dedicate ourselves to peace."

His words point to the <u>Family Federation</u>'s belief that global change begins with the cultivation of peace within the individual and family, a principle that has long been central to the movement's teachings.

Song Yong-Cheon, President of the Family Federation in South Korea, framed the moment

"Heaven is calling us to be reborn as a pure community of faith."

By urging a return to the essence, <u>Song</u> highlighted the importance of internal renewal while also pledging to strengthen the transparency and fairness of the <u>Federation</u>'s organizational systems:

"We will begin concrete institutional reforms for transparent operations and strengthen a fair and rational personnel system."

Such commitments demonstrate an awareness that credibility and integrity are inseparable from spiritual authority.

Importantly, the <u>Federation</u> did not shy away from addressing contemporary challenges. A representative openly acknowledged recent investigations and social concerns:

"We deeply recognize our moral responsibility [...]. We are taking this as an opportunity for deep reflection and renewal, with the aim of fulfilling the essential role of religion before society, the nation, and the world."

This frank admission illustrates a willingness to transform criticism into an occasion for growth and reform, aligning with the <u>organization</u>'s emphasis on moral responsibility and accountability.

A spokesperson for the <u>Family Federation</u> also situated its mission within a wider geopolitical and spiritual context,

"Amid growing nationalism and global conflicts, we are also dedicating special prayers so that Korea can overcome trials and crises, achieve greater prosperity and development, and fully play its divinely appointed role as the center of peace on the Korean peninsula and in the world."

Here, the <u>Federation</u> connected its faith practices to Korea's destiny, reinforcing its conviction that Korea has a <u>providential</u> role in advancing global peace.

This year also marks the 71st anniversary of the movement's <u>founding</u>. With the grand <u>opening of the Cheonwon Temple</u> in April and a new organizational structure centered on mission, administration, and education, the <u>Federation</u> is signaling its readiness to advance its guiding vision: "One Human Family under <u>God</u>". Through its programs for healthy families, Korean reunification, and international peace, the <u>movement</u> continues to extend its founders' legacy into the future.

In sum, the large event on September 5, can be said to be not just a memorial but a moment of renewal. It reveals a faith community embracing both reflection and reform, committed to peace in the family, society, and world.

## Making a way in the desert – newly appointed Director of the World Mission Headquarters of the Family Federation quotes Isaiah in introductory speech

A speech delivered 22nd August 2025 by Doo Seung-yeon (두승연), newly appointed as Director of the World Mission Headquarters of the Family Federation on 15<sup>th</sup> August. Dear beloved blessed families, respected leaders of Cheonil-guk, greetings. I am Doo Seung-yeon (두승연), newly appointed as Director



of the World Mission Headquarters on 15<sup>th</sup> August (solar calendar), entrusted with a new providential responsibility.

I am deeply grateful to stand here today in this precious and gracious place. I pray that the love and blessings of our Heavenly Parent and the **True Parents** of Heaven, Earth, and Humankind will overflow upon all of you who have joined us for this [...] vigil.

According to the schedule, I was given 13 minutes. But today is a special time, so please forgive me if I may take a little more time.

The reason is that Mother has reorganized and restructured the organization, and the full providential reasons were not completely conveyed in the official notice. So tonight, before our global family who are watching, I wish to share this content with you. I ask for your understanding if my message takes a little longer. Thank you.

Before beginning, I would like to read a verse from the Bible:

> "See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland." (Isaiah 43:19)

In worldly terms, our path has often been misunderstood. criticized, or even condemned. Yet God has never been bound by human perspectives; He always opens a new way according to His will. Just as the Lord proclaimed through Isaiah, even now. Heavenly Parent is making a road in the wilderness and streams in the desert.

When we look at Isaiah 43, the people of Judah had lost their sovereignty, their temple, and their pride as a nation after Jerusalem was destroyed by Babylon. They lived as captives, abandoned and in despair, wondering if God had forsaken them. In that moment, Isaiah 43 was proclaimed as a message of comfort and hope. Especially verse 19 – "I will do a new thing" – was Heaven's declaration of restoration to those despairing in exile.

God has always prepared new eras. He called Abraham and made him the father of faith. Through Moses, He opened the path of the Exodus. Through Jesus Christ, He opened the way of new life for all humanity.





This sacred name, Holy Mother Han, is the new, holy title bestowed by Heavenly Parent upon True Mother. It encompasses all her missions and roles: the

Only Begotten Daughter, True Mother, substantial Holy Spirit, embodiment of Heavenly Parent, fulfillment of history, and the one who has brought completion to the providence.

True Mother, the Only Begotten Daughter, fulfilled all conditions as True Parent and, with the dedication of the Cheonwon Temple and Cheonil Sanctum this past April, has ushered in a new era – the era



where Heavenly Parent dwells on earth and the history of Heaven and humankind reaches completion.

This is the age in which Heavenly Parent directly dwells as the owner of this earth, embracing and loving His children. It is the age where the world is brought into oneness under His sovereignty, and humanity lives as one family under Heavenly Parent.

Therefore, with the name of *Holy Mother Han*, True Mother proclaimed to all Heaven and earth that the gates of Cheonil-guk, the Kingdom of Heaven, are now wide open.

Even now, our second, third, and fourth generation blessed children are showing to the world the reality of living together with our Heavenly Parent on earth. How proud we can be of this!

Beloved blessed families, the providence is not something that can be judged or measured from a human-centered viewpoint. All leaders and members must listen deeply to Heaven's voice, awaken, and live as righteous people chosen by Heaven. We must pray and devote ourselves daily, seeking Heaven's guidance to solve all problems.

True Mother, as the Only Begotten Daughter, bore the central providential responsibility to welcome Heavenly Parent into the Cheonwon Temple and the the Cheonil Sanctum – the substantial temple of Cheonil-guk. For this, she established Cheon Jeong Won as the providential hub, preparing the environment to attend our Heavenly Parent.

Now, however, we are entering a new era where Heavenly Parent Himself directly guides and governs. On 15<sup>th</sup> August, True Mother solemnly proclaimed the start of this new era and new history.

Up until now, it was the age when True Parents' sacrifices built the foundation, and "children" offered victory reports. But now begins the age where "children", united as one, directly offer the fruits of victory to our Heavenly Parent and True Parents.

In other words, this is no longer the age of "children" passively receiving from parents, but the age of matured "children" who prepare a feast of devotion and love for their Parents, bringing them joy.

Through this proclamation, True Mother has concluded the Cheon Jeong Won system and established a new *three-organization system* for the fulfillment of the providence:

- The World Mission Headquarters responsible for global evangelism.
- The Central Administration responsible for organizational governance.
- The Future Talent Training Center preparing the next generations.

This is a great providential victory and development.

Once again, let us offer unending gratitude, praise, and glory to True Mother, Holy Mother Han, who has proclaimed the start of this new era and new history.

Beloved families and leaders, your faith and devotion are the greatest strength in opening this new age. True Mother loves each and every one of us deeply. Do you feel it? She promises that our efforts and devotion will be remembered not only on earth but eternally in the spirit world.

Let us respond to this infinite love and grace by living as true Cheonilguk citizens who fulfill our responsibilities.

Even now, countless blessed families around the world are joining in devotion through Cheongshimwon [a prayer hall in Gapyeong] and internet broadcasts. I truly respect and honor your sincerity.

As True Mother declared this new era, she also reminded President Lee Kiseong to be a witness to this moment. All of you here tonight in this special vigil are likewise witnesses and participants in the beginning of this new history.

Through our devotion, let us open wide the path of expanding Cheonil-guk's realm with ever deeper filial piety and love for the True Parents.

To all who are gathered here [...], I sincerely pray for Heavenly Parent's abundant love, blessings, and great victory to be with you always.
