By now you may have heard the breaking news that a court in Korea has just issued an arrest warrant for True Mother, as requested by government prosecutors. Under Korean law, this means that True Mother will be now held in custody for a period of about ten days while the prosecution continues its investigation.

Our entire community is shocked and saddened by this decision and we will continue our prayers for True Mother's health and safety. We will share more details with you as soon as we are able to do so.

Mother herself is in good spirits, confident as always in the protection and guidance of God. Let's all take deeply to heart her words to us from yesterday:

"Do not worry about me. Do not pray for me. Please pray and offer devotion for you and your families, our whole Unification family, and that the Will of our Heavenly Parent may be fulfilled. I love you, blessed families."

We are reminded that both in biblical and contemporary times, the champions of God were often arrested by governments, yet God turned the situation around. Thus it was with Joseph, with Daniel, and with Paul; with so many of the Saints, and in our times with Martin Luther King Jr., Nelson Mandela, and with True Father, who was released from Danbury prison 40 years ago to a welcome from thousands of Christian ministers.

Beloved members, let us truly unite in heart, love, word, prayer and deed with our Holy Mother Han, True Mother, so that together with God we may achieve a final victory.
