And above all, I believe that <u>True Mother</u>, who is confined in that difficult and suffocating place, is drawing her strength from the sincerity and love of her "sons and daughters" all over the world. For that, I'm deeply grateful once again. [...]

As you know, during the ten minutes we're allowed for visitation, we want to talk as much as we can, listen to her words, and if possible, even sing a song she loves - but the time always feels too short.

So before each visit, we go through a checklist: what we need to prepare for <u>True Mother</u> that day, what questions to ask, and so on. [...]

After the Chuseok holiday, <u>True Mother</u> seemed somewhat troubled, perhaps because there were things she needed or matters she wanted to discuss. She actually asked to see one of the staff yesterday, but we couldn't arrange it then. So today we decided to begin by listening carefully to whatever she needed first.

When we entered, <u>True Mother</u> was already there, sitting in her wheelchair. I felt sorry that she had been waiting. She sat with her eyes closed, looking very serious. Before the visit officially begins, we can't speak to each other - no sound passes through - so we just sat looking at her quietly as she rested with her eyes closed.

Then, when the announcement came that the visitation time had started, <u>True Mother</u> opened her eyes, looked at us, and we offered our bows.

To be honest, I hadn't shared about her complexion yesterday, but today, when I saw her sitting there with her eyes closed and that very serious expression, she looked so weary. Usually, she greets us so gently, always smiling and serene. But today, sitting there alone like that, she looked exhausted. Those who were with me also commented that she seemed deep in serious thought.

The staff who care for her on the inside often tell us about her health. They say that when she closes her eyes for long periods, it's usually because she's extremely tired and her eyes are fatigued. She hasn't been sleeping well either, which worries us.

When I saw her last Friday after Chuseok, she was sweating heavily - so much that her hair was soaked as if she had just taken a shower. She kept wiping her face and neck with a towel, and because of that, her skin became irritated, with small pimples and blemishes breaking out on her normally beautiful face. She received ointment for it, and while the redness has subsided a bit, new spots have appeared, which makes us suspect that her body's inflammation levels might be high.

We discussed making sure that if she ever feels discomfort or pain anywhere, she can receive a proper medical checkup. We don't know exactly how things will go, but since it's a health matter, we agreed it's important to keep raising it.

As many of you know, <u>True Mother</u> has symptoms of arrhythmia. Although she received treatment, it has recurred. Lately, I've noticed that when she breathes, her chest rises and falls more noticeably than before - as if breathing itself takes more effort. Even missionary Shinheung Moon noticed that her breathing rhythm isn't steady - it varies between long and short breaths - which worries us about whether her heart is under strain.

Earlier this year in the U.S., she overexerted herself and was hospitalized, nearly developing pneumonia. At that time, the young Pure Waters [group of volunteers] wanted to see her, and even though she was unwell, she insisted on meeting them. But those around her earnestly asked her to rest for her health. So now, every time we see her, we try to pay close attention to how she's doing.

Normally, <u>True Mother</u> always sits with perfect posture - straight-backed and dignified - whether she's

watching the news or a documentary. But today, she seemed unable to keep her back straight, sitting slightly hunched as if she lacked strength. It made me feel she was truly tired. I also noticed some strands of white hair showing - normally they grow in from the roots, but these looked more like scattered streaks of gray, which made me think she must be deeply preoccupied and stressed these days.

I'm sorry to share such worrying news with all of you from the start. But even in such physical hardship and difficult circumstances, <u>True Mother</u> continues to encourage us. She always says that the truth will be revealed, that Heaven will work, and that we must stay strong. She says she herself is enduring patiently and waiting.

So, please don't be discouraged or angry when you hear this. Even in her suffering, she thinks of us and gives us strength. Let us also stay strong, and offer even more sincere prayers for <u>True Mother</u>. [...]

And because she knows the hearts of all the members around the world who offer their devotion and love, she hopes we will all stay strong and united.

Then, noticing that <u>True Mother</u>'s posture seemed a bit slouched and she looked weak, we asked gently if her back was hurting. She replied that her back was fine, but with the weather getting colder, her shoulders and neck felt very chilly. She said she's wearing thermal clothes but still feels the cold deeply.

Then, instead of complaining, she said, "Well, that's just how the season is," and began worrying about us instead. "Are you all doing well? Don't catch a cold. Stay strong."

I felt that these final words weren't just for us there, but for all our beloved blessed families and children around the world. She has often told us, "Stay healthy, so we can live together on this earth for a long, long time," and I want to pass that message on again today:

"Are you all well? Don't catch a cold. Stay strong."

[...] Just then, the time ran out, so we couldn't say more.

That was how our ten-minute visit went today. It may sound a bit scattered, but I wanted to share everything with you.

We'll continue doing our best to share with you the conversations, impressions, and updates about <u>True Mother</u>'s health tomorrow, the day after, and through Friday.

Please stay strong. We love you. Thank you.



Now that the holiday is over, we've returned to our normal daily lives. From Monday to Friday, visits to True Mother are possible again.

I've heard that visits have already been scheduled for every day this week – Monday through Friday.

For our part, [...] we are trying our best to keep everyone updated about what you are all most curious about: True Mother's current condition.
[...]

And as for me, even if you think, "Why is she coming out again and talking for so long?" please bear with me – I'll try to keep my words brief.

Today, [...] we first offered a bow of respect and then greeted **True**Mother, asking how she was doing. Actually, last Friday, five members of the **True Parents**' direct family went to visit her. [...]

She asked, "How are Shin-chul and Shin-heung doing?"

At that moment, Shin-chul Moon, though a bit saddened, mentioned the recent news reports related to an unofficial "emergency response committee" that were inaccurate.

Yes – there were a few mistaken reports in several outlets, and because of those misleading and misunderstanding-filled stories, we worried that True Mother might have been concerned upon hearing them. So Shin-chul Moon explained to her that he had already spoken well with the chairperson and clarified everything.

Then True Mother said, "Good, keep talking with them."

Shin-chul Moon also reported,

"The news report doesn't reflect the chairperson's opinions. It also doesn't represent the whole group – It's just the independent actions of two or three individuals."

Then True Mother said.

"It's okay. Heaven will work. The truth will surely be revealed. It may take time, but the truth always comes out. What can I do? I will endure and wait."

[...] True Mother keeps emphasizing to us:

"The truth will surely be revealed. But it may take time."

Even for True Mother, this whole situation must be deeply painful and frustrating. To think that she, who lived on earth with True Father, must now stay in such humble and




A typical 6m² cell at Seoul Detention Center where Mother Han is being held, possibly for many months. Image: Chat GPT, 10th October 2025.

circumstances – it's natural that she would feel sorrow and even indignation. In that situation, I can imagine **True Mother** feeling apologetic toward Heaven as well.

But even so, she said, "I will endure and wait." She believes that the truth she knows will one day be revealed. Until then, she hopes we will move forward as one, holding onto that truth.

She also said,



"This nation is not above Heaven. This nation exists under Heaven. We must attend Heaven. The laws of this nation cannot order Heaven to do this or that."

After that, Shin-chul Moon mentioned that because of the news reports, many people now misunderstand things even more. So he told Mother.

"To clear up misunderstandings, we're preparing ways to explain True Parents' life course in a simple, understandable way."

True Mother replied,

"Just teach the *Principles of Creation*. It's about attending Heaven – becoming people who can attend our Heavenly Parent on earth. Humanity must be reborn through the *True Parents* in order to attend our Heavenly Parent. So, speak about the *Principles of Creation*. If people hear that, they won't misunderstand."

Please remember these words from True Mother. Going forward, we should confidently testify before the world about our Heavenly Parent's dream – how Heaven has worked, and how True Parents have walked the path to fulfill that dream.

[...] True Mother said,

"That's how it should be. The chosen people have a responsibility. We must not become like the Israelites of the past. This is a very important moment – The chosen people must fulfill their role."

Indeed, True Mother views this time as one of the most crucial moments. Under the protection and guidance of the True Parents, Korea – and all blessed families around the world – have been chosen, called, and protected as Heaven's people.

Now, since we've received that much love and protection, True Mother again reminded us that this is the time to fulfill our responsibility as Heaven's chosen people.

Please keep this in your prayers today. If we sincerely pray about this, Heaven will surely grant us wisdom. [...]

True Mother [...] said, "How can we face such a world?" and spoke a bit about the state of the nation's laws. But at the end, she gave us words of encouragement, saying, "Let's stay strong."

Everyone, since Mother said, "Let's stay strong," even though you might feel empty or unmotivated, or have no appetite or trouble sleeping, let's keep our spirits up and live with hearts united with Mother. [...]

True Mother usually sits in a wheelchair, and as you know, when you sit for long periods, your body stiffens – you get numb legs, back pain, and so on.

So True Mother said she often moves her ankles up and down while sitting, to help circulation. She reminded the staff not to forget that simple exercise.

She also said it's good to stretch your arms up high – like when you shout "Mansei!" – and wiggle your



fingers. That kind of movement helps blood circulation.

Move your ankles too. We also sit for hours at a time, so we should remember to

move our ankles and do these exercises whenever we can.

When she was told this, True Mother replied, "I'll try."

And that's how today's conversation with True Mother concluded.
