Mrs. Selle reported about 300 people attended the event and many participants requested more information about the unification of the Korean Peninsula. Vice President of WFWP USA Katarina Connery stated, "In order for the unity of the Korean Peninsula, we must unite centered on God and True Parents."

Dr. Achille Acolatse spoke about the upcoming <u>African Diaspora Leadership Conference</u> taking place on July 12-15 at the International Peace Education Center (IPEC) in Las Vegas, Nevada, for the purpose of connecting and educating people of the African diaspora about True Parents' vision for a heavenly Africa.
