GPA returns to UTS in Barrytown, NY for their Kick-Off Workshop Part 2

Generation Peace Academy (GPA) returned to the Unification Theological Seminary (UTS) for their Part 2: Kick-Off workshop from September 24 to 28. The workshop was also blessed with a visit from Naokimi Ushiroda who shared his testimony of how his three years on Special Task Force (STF) were crucial in instilling in him a sense of God's will. It is based on that foundation that he has become the National Director of Youth and Students Ministry.

With the conclusion of the Part 2: Kick-Off workshop, GPA students have headed out on their first 12-day fundraising commitment to apply all they have learned.
