

## **Staff change at *Way of the World* Hal McKenzie replaces Young Tyang Chang**

On October 17th, 1972, our Leader appointed Hal McKenzie as Editor-in-Chief of *Way of the World*, taking the place of Mr. Young Tyang Chang. Mr. Chang will become advising editor of *Way of the World*, and remain Chief Editor of the "Weekly Religion" and Manager of "Grass and Star," a poetry magazine.

Other changes are: Miss Lynne Doerfler [Kim] will be Editor, and Mr. Han Joo Cha will become Advising Editor.

The change reflects a basic shift in the operation of *Way of the World*.

Formerly the magazine was Korean-run with Western members advising; now it will be Western-run with Korean members advising. This change, initiated by our Leader, is in line with *Way of the World's* role as a publication designed mainly for Western Family.
