The recipients were selected based on their results from the previous year, participating in meetings and PR presentations. The awards were directly presented by Secretary General Sun-Pyo Hong. Ilsang Ocean Development Deputy Whi-Chan was selected as the Best PR Reporter of 2014, and Seilo Section Chief Hyung-Joon Kwon was selected as the Outstanding PR Reporter of 2014.
