At this event, FFWPU Daegu Branch Director Dong-Won Jeong explained the significance of the "Hope for Korea! Marching Forward for the Harmonious Unification of the Nation Rallies on the Town (-eub), Township (-myeon) and Village (-dong) Levels" that were recently being held by the FFWPU throughout the nation, as part of the keynote address.

Director Jeong elaborated on the FFWPU's late founder Rev. Sun Myung Moon's contributions toward the end of the Cold War, and emphasized the need for everyone to overcome the difficulties surrounding the nuclear armament of North Korea, as well as to alleviate tensions on the Korean Peninsula by taking part in the unification and true families movements that are centered on the concept of unification as brothers and sisters.
