The third Korean Divine Principle workshop was held at the International Peace Education Center (IPEC) in Las Vegas from April 13 to 16.

A total of 38 people participated from New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, California, Texas, and Nevada. The schedule was filled with lectures on the Divine Principle and tours to various important sites of the Unification movement.

Participant Bok-Im Kim, an Ambassador for Peace from Los Angeles, heard True Mother's voice from True Parents' photo displayed in the lecture hall on the first day of the workshop. She heard True Mother say, "Welcome! Everyone who attends this workshop are like the light of the world." She also had a dream in which the True Parents embraced her so she could sleep well and be comfortable.
