After the videos, 25 children who had been playing soccer or swimming while their parents received the lecture, rejoined their families for a BBQ dinner that included the traditional hot dogs and hamburgers, chips and sodas, and watermelon offered by the church and potluck side dishes and desserts brought by attending guests and members.

During conversation over the meal, guests got to know each other and the members who had invited them. Several members without guests were also included in these conversations and helped make the atmosphere upbeat and jovial. Guests commented that their experience with the lectures was very good. Some commented that " it looks like the Blessing will be a beautiful and spirit filled event". Agreeing that the family is really very important and noting that the difficulties in today's society "are often the result of broken families", the table conversations also included testimonies about the guests own families and

stories about people they knew. Everyone was involved and interested throughout these conversations and left the event with hopeful hearts.



Las Vegas will host a Marriage Blessing Ceremony at IPEC on August 26th and it is expected that most of the BBQ guests will go on to participate in that event. Hopefully, they will also bring family and friends to observe and appreciate this special and holy ceremony.
