Rev. Moon's Matches Going Strong after Thirty Years - Joshua Cotter

Rev. Joshua Cotter, the keynote speaker, said that he "enjoyed every second of [the past 30 years with his wife] and would not trade it for anything."

More than 400 of the 8,000 couples who were Blessed in marriage by Rev. and Mrs. Sun Myung Moon in 1982 celebrated their 30th Anniversary with their families at the Hammerstein Ballroom of the Manhattan Center on July 1, 2012. Broadcast live by satellite across the nation, the event opened with footage of the Blessings for 2,075 couples in Madison Square Garden and for 6,000 couples in Korea, as well as video testimonies from Unificationists who had attended either ceremony.

At noon earlier that day, couples were invited to gather in front of Madison Square Garden for a commemorative picture, together with their families. Many couples enthusiastically posed for the cameras in a "dip-kiss" pose as a public display of affection that has lasted thirty years. At the gala, Master of Ceremonies and National Youth Pastor for Lovin' Life Ministries Jaga Gavin thanked these couples, saying, "You [1982 couples] never gave up on our True Parents. Our True Parents are here because of your faith. For us, the second-generation and young Unificationists, everything that we could inherit from you is incredible. So thank you so much for your commitment to God, True Parents, each other and us, and we hope that you could be at our 30th anniversary one day."

Gavin then introduced Rev. Joshua Cotter, vice president of the Unification Church USA and also a 1982 couple, as the keynote speaker for the event, whose remarks are included below. 1982 couple Tyndol and Imgard Ganes symbolically presented a gift to True Parents, and Pastor Gavin retook the podium to read congratulatory letters from Dr. Chang Shik Yang, continental director for the Unification Church and Dr. Joseph Lowery. Robert Sayer, a board member of the Blessed Families Association and also a 1982 couple, explained about the "2,075 Blessing Memories Project," which is an effort to collect photos and testimonies from the 1982 couples publish a book to present to Rev. and Mrs. Sun Myung Moon on Foundation Day. Pastor Gavin explained the work of the BlessedLIFE Ministry, which is "focused to be able to support people in marriage preparation, Blessing preparation, as well as supporting and enhancing existing marriages through education and empowerment," and welcomed the attendees to partake in a dinner of traditional Korean foods.

Entertainment included Laurel Nakai, daughter of Sayer, who performed an original song. "I am so proud to be able to share in this anniversary and to know that your Blessing is part of my lineage," she said.

"My husband also comes from the 1982 Blessing, so our family, our children, is all because of the commitment you made and True parents. Thank you and happy anniversary."

Jana Iparraguirre and Kester Wilkening, second-generation Unificationists whose parents had attended the Blessing in 1982, performed a Waltz, which was followed by two more ballroom-dance exhibitions performed by the Blessed Teens Academy and graduates of Generation Peace Academy. *Sonic Cult* performed several numbers, and afterwards, the floor was opened for a night of ballroom dancing between fathers and daughters and mothers and sons.

Remarks from Rev. Cotter

"Congratulations to all of you, but most especially, congratulations to Heavenly Father and True Parents on this glorious, historic occasion," said Rev. Cotter. "Thank you, True Parents. Our True Parents are with us once again in Las Vegas. My beloved wife, who hasn't aged a day, is with them and they celebrated our anniversary this morning in Las Vegas. As our True Parents think about the 30 years of our Blessing, the fact that we're here, the fact that we have followed them faithfully, I'm sure that they are moved."

Rev. Cotter read a letter addressed to True Parents from 1982-Blessing attendee Betsy Orman, who wrote the following: "Words cannot express the depth of gratitude that we have for the incredible Blessing we were given by you 30 years ago. You raised us up, removed our Original Sin and saved our lives, you gave us spouses that indeed became the catalyst for not only our own perfection, but our earthly and eternal happiness. The result of your sacrifice, all of our beautiful and gifted children, we owe and dedicate to you for the fulfillment of God's will. Only as we now seek to Bless them can we begin to realize the tremendous sacrifices you have both made for all of us. On this anniversary, we hope that in some small way, we can show you how much we love you, how much we want to thank you. Know that we are still here, still standing and still faithful to you in the ideals you set before us. On this 30th anniversary, we want to rededicate ourselves to the fulfillment of God's will."

In the spirit of reliving his wedding day, Rev. Cotter shared about his first meeting with his wife. "When True Parents Blessed me with my wife – I really was stubbornly insistent upon a Korean wife – I had no idea if she spoke any English," he said. "But the first thing she said to me, in a British accent, was 'Don't worry, I speak perfect English.' I was blown away. It was perfect and it was English! *English* English. She had come from London, where she was raised and had joined the church. I was just thrilled.

"Beloved Brothers and Sisters of the 2,075 and 6,000 Couples' Blessings, I want to sincerely congratulate you on this occasion, the thirtieth anniversary of your holy weddings. I regret that I cannot be with you in person but duty has me attending our True Parents.

"Our True Parents are in the best of health and we have many of the True Grandchildren with us! Even though the temperature in Las Vegas is 108 degrees Fahrenheit, True Father goes out to Lake Mead as soon as Hoon Dok Hwe is over, to offer his devotion to God through fishing. Testimony from the Ichijos

First-generation couple Yoshi and Fran Ichijo, who were matched in 1978 in Korea, offered a humorous and touching testimony about their martial relationship.

Fran Ichijo said, "When I called my mother from Korea, I said, 'Mom, I'm engaged.' She said, 'Who is it?' I said, 'He's Japanese.' She said, 'They are the enemy!' My mother said that! She was from that generation. I said, 'Mom it's ok, he's great.' She said, 'What's his name?' I said, 'Yoshihiro Ichijo.' She said, 'I can't even say it.' But now my mother loves her three grandchildren, and we have a grandchild so now she loves her great-grandchild, her first one, more than anything in the world, and she loves all of our family, so she had a big turnaround from all of those days. This is a testimony to our True Parents. We thank our True Parents for everything because they gave us the vision to make it work, make it happen and make the best family we could possibly make."

Yoshi Ichijo: "We Japanese are not trained to express our love. So, many nights – no, few times – [laughter] I think there was a misunderstanding. I didn't know what love meant. I didn't know how to convey my love for her. I'm from the eastern culture and she's from the west. But father matched us and he said, 'When the two extremes are united, anybody, anything in between will be totally united.' Because of the vision and the principles our True Parents gave us, the struggle wasn't easy but easier because we shared the same vision to build an ideal family. We dealt with any situation. We learned how to improve our relationship. One thing I learned was that men have a stronger ego than women, but I learned that we need to be humble to accept the truth, which means, if we are wrong, we accept it."
