

FFWPU Zambia's Prayer Breakfast: National Healing Through Religious Unity

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Resolution for Spiritual Solidarity and Peace

The Universal Peace Federation Zambia chapter, together with the Inter-religious Association for Peace and Development (IAPD), held a prayer breakfast on July 22 in Lusaka with the theme 'National Healing Through Religious Unity.' This event brought together leaders from various religious denominations including Christianity, Islam, Hinduism, and Bahá'í, as well as representatives from civil society.



This prayer meeting was held during the national mourning period following the passing of Zambia's 6th President, the late Edgar Chagwa Lungu, and became an occasion to strengthen resolve for spiritual solidarity and peace.

Representatives from each religious denomination mourned
