

KCLC July Prayer Meeting Expanding Christian Environmental Rights

The Korea Clergy Leadership Conference (KCLC) prayer meeting was held on July 15 on the 4th floor of the Family Federation headquarters building in Cheongpa-dong, Yongsan-gu, Seoul.

This prayer meeting was a meaningful occasion to reaffirm the mission of inter-religious solidarity and peace amid recent inter-religious tensions within Korea and social misunderstandings surrounding the Family Federation. The clergy who attended the prayer meeting expressed deep concern about the religious persecution and misunderstandings that the Family Federation is experiencing, and conveyed deep respect and gratitude to Holy Mother Han, True Mother, who steadfastly follows Heavenly Parent's providence and practices the path of love and peace.



In particular, they prayed for True Mother's health and well-being, and pledged to unite and dedicate themselves more fully in upholding her will. The event began under the guidance of Chairman Yang Jong-eun of the Methodist Church. Pastor Shin Ho-cheol of Hanuri Church emphasized KCLC's identity and mission of advancing toward God through the representative prayer.

Following this, the Hyo Jeong Peace Unification Choir's praise song "Happiness" united the hearts of all participants. Pastor Han Won-jeon of the Christian Right Culture Practice Council emphasized through his sermon, based on Genesis chapters 1-2, "the awareness and practice of being participants in God's creative work." Pastor Han also emphasized that "KCLC should take the lead in reclaiming the original mission of creation in accordance with the will of Holy Mother Han, True Mother, who is the founder."

Hong Yun-jong, Chairman of the Korea Clergy Leadership Conference, emphasized in his greeting that "KCLC, as a worship community transcending denominations and sects, should practice the vision of 'One Family of Humankind under God' and contribute to North-South unification and the realization of a Heavenly Unified Korea." He requested that KCLC become the foundation stone for expanding Christian environmental rights. The unison prayer that day was led by Co- Chairman Pastor Seo Jin-woo. Under the message that "prayer is not a simple request but deep communion with Heaven and an expression of love," all participants prayed with utmost sincerity and experienced the power of a united community.
