

FFWPU International: Texas: Joint Prayer Gathering for Religious Freedom

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Hope Through Interreligious Solidarity

A joint prayer gathering for religious freedom was held on November 21 at the Dallas - Fort Worth Family Church.

The event featured an interreligious joint prayer ceremony, a musical performance by Mr. David Fessenden and a keynote address by Mr. Peter Harris, chairman of the Alliance for Religious Freedom and Human Rights, followed by faith testimonies and night vigil devotions.

In his keynote address, Chairman Harris emphasized that "religious freedom strengthens individuals, families, social communities, and nations," underscoring the hope that it can be realized through interreligious cooperation.

During the testimony session, Serge Milogo shared a case study highlighting cooperation between Christians and Muslims, while Professor Trong Phan introduced examples from the Catholic community that highlighted the importance of religious freedom in Vietnam.

The program concluded with night vigil devotions, during which participants expressed shared recognition of the need for solidarity and cooperation among people of faith.
