

ACLIC Visit to Korea Strengthens Cooperation with KCLC and Promotes Religious Freedom

A delegation of pastors from the American Clergy Leadership Conference (ACLIC) visited Korea from December 2 to 5 to strengthen cooperation with the Korea Clergy Leadership Conference (KCLC).

During their visit, the ACLIC delegation prayed for religious freedom at the Original Cheongpa-dong Headquarters Church and held discussions with Heavenly Korea Family Federation President Dr. Song Yong-cheon on ways to promote interreligious exchange.

The delegation also attended a "Forum on Religious Freedom and Social Responsibility" held in Cheonan, where participants exchanged perspectives on the importance of religious freedom.

In addition, the delegation gathered in unity at a peace prayer rally in front of the Seoul Detention Center, and visited Cheon Won Gung, where they reflected on the achievements of the True Parents and reaffirmed the vision of one human family centered on Heavenly Parent.
