Shifting from Heaven as a Concept to the Reality of Life

Dear respected and beloved Unificationist Blessed Families and Members around the world:

The new year of 2026, the year of the Fire Horse (丙午), has dawned. Happy New Year to you and your family. As we welcome this new year, I pray that the grace and love of Heavenly Parent and True Parents will overflow ever more abundantly upon your families and on the foundations you are building with your lives.

At this moment, we are hearing a powerful calling to "change" - from Heavenly Parent, from the world and from our community, and even from the depths of our own conscience.



This call is not merely a notice to prepare for change, but rather a solemn warning bell awakening us to realities that have already changed, yet which we have failed to fully recognize. Because we have not kept up with the speed and weightiness of the times, the confusion and pain we feel today have grown within that widening gap.

Our Second and Third Generation members, in particular, are sensing this changed era more keenly than anyone and are already creating new paths. The gap between them and the hesitant First Generation is manifesting itself as a painful reality of a "generation gap," further deepening our concerns.

True Mother has taught us, quoting the Bible, Luke 12:10, "Everyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man will be forgiven, but anyone who blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven."

I would like to reflect on these words in the language of today: "Those who go against tradition can be forgiven, but those who go against the flow of the times cannot be forgiven."

Tradition is a protective fence we must cherish and defend, but it must not become shackles to bind the footsteps of future generations. True tradition should be a firm foundation upon which the next generation can stand and freely flourish.

We must humbly reflect on the fact that a tradition that clings only to past ways can become a burden to the flow of the times. The flow of times is the very course of the blueprint for the providence that Heavenly Parent presents to us, and it is therefore a path we cannot go against.



External Change: Concrete Practices of Untangling Knots on the Ground

This is the internal attitude of change that this era powerfully demands of us. Jesus said, Matthew 16:19, "Whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in

heaven."

The starting point of these words is not heaven, but the very "earth" upon which we stand. Heaven is the place of results, and earth is the place of causes. Just as we cannot expect fruit without sowing seeds, unless we untie the tangled knots in our families, churches and workplaces, between spouses and between parents and children, they will not be untied in heaven either.

If we say we love the invisible God yet cannot love our visible spouses, and children, and brothers and sisters, we deceive ourselves.

Now is the time to leave behind a heaven that exists only in ideas and come down to the reality of life. This change must never be something we demand only of others. Before speaking of others, I must change first.

The one who binds and looses on earth is "me," and no one else can take responsibility on my behalf. This is the external attitude and the virtue of practice that this era powerfully demands of us.
