


Become True Sons and Daughters of Cheon Il Guk Who Fulfill Our Responsibility

1. Summary of Last Week's Message

Last week, we reaffirmed both our identity and our commitment to live as chosen blessed families who attend Heavenly Parent substantially in our daily lives. In particular, through the teaching that "the Kingdom of Heaven is a world resembling the form of a single human being," we inscribed upon our hearts the heavenly order that the pain or love of one person extends to the entire community. 2. Our Responsibility: Walking the Path of True Love to Build True Families

This week, we turn our attention to the third theme of the New Year motto - our mission:

"In the 13th year of Cheon Il Guk, when we attend the Creator Heavenly Parent substantially, let us, the blessed families around the world, become true sons and daughters of Cheon Il Guk who fulfill our responsibility as the chosen people in unity with True Parents!"


Accordingly, this week I would like to share with you about our mission: to become true sons and daughters of Cheon Il Guk who faithfully fulfill our responsibility.

First, let us briefly clarify the "responsibility" Heaven desires us to fulfill. In response to the providential demands of this age, we have been chosen and established as blessed families, a chosen people, and with that calling Heaven has entrusted us with a clear mission and responsibility. This responsibility is not a task reserved for a select few; rather, it is the path originally intended for all people - a path Heaven now calls the blessed families to walk ahead of others. At its core, this responsibility, which we must be the first to take on and which all humanity must ultimately fulfill, is to practice true love and to establish a true family.

The Principle of Creation teaches us this responsibility clearly. Heavenly Parent prepared the main part of the providence for the accomplishment of the purpose of creation - the realization of the kingdom of heaven on earth. But Heavenly Parent gave human beings responsibility to place the final piece in the puzzle. This responsibility means that we, by our free will, obey Heavenly Parent's Word, practice true love, establish true families, and thereby bring the kingdom of heaven on earth into reality.

Heavenly Parent, who exists without form, created this vast cosmos in order to experience in substance the joy and happiness of true love - something never seen, touched, or felt before - through a true family composed of husband, wife, and children.

Thus, only when people fulfill the responsibility they have been entrusted with can they truly stand as Heavenly Parent's son or daughter. At that moment, God becomes not an abstract concept but a parent. And through the fruits of such a life, Cheon Il Guk - the kingdom of heaven on earth - ceases to be just an ideal and becomes a reality to be completed in our daily lives.



3. Responsibility Fulfilled Through the Foundations of Faith and Substance

The path of responsibility - of practicing true love and establishing true families - is not a task completed all at once, but a journey that is undertaken gradually within the framework of Heaven's providence. In principle, this path of responsibility can be understood through two streams: the foundation of faith and the foundation of substance. The foundation of faith is the stage of receiving Heavenly Parent's Will and the ideal of the true family through the Word, believing in that path, and standing at the starting line of taking responsibility.

This is like the blueprint of a building. A blueprint contains the purpose and structure of the completed building, yet the building cannot be erected by the blueprint alone. At the same time, without the blueprint, construction cannot even begin. In the same way, the foundation of faith is the stage of clearly inscribing Heaven's ideal of true love and true family into the heart, and then the journey of responsibility begins based upon this design.

Heaven's ultimate desire is not faith that remains at the level of the blueprint, but rather, the foundation of substance - the realization of that will in the sphere of life. The foundation of substance is like the process of actually constructing the building according to the design, which requires time, patience, practice, and sacrifice. The responsibility of practicing true love and establishing a true family is completed only within this foundation of substance. When the Word becomes daily life and faith is embodied in relationships,

Cheon Il Guk ceases to be an ideal and is established in the lives of each and every family.

4. Practice: Expressing a Heart of Gratitude to Our Parents
