Closing Service - 70-Day Witnessing Campaign

On Sunday, April 5, 2026, the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification in the DRC organized a national service marking the conclusion of the 70-day witnessing campaign. This large-scale event was held simultaneously across 42 local churches nationwide, mobilizing a total of 3,102 members and welcoming 133 guests across the country.

National Celebration and Keynote Address

In Kinshasa, the main hub of the celebration, 923 members and 37 guests attended the solemn service. The central message, delivered by National Leader Reverend RANG WAN LUBAKA, focused on the theme: "Becoming a Pillar of a New and Restored Nation."
