This collective honesty paved the way for renewed strategic direction. The session concluded with revised targets, the establishment of accountability pairs, and realigned resources. Before the final prayer, each leader made a public pledge, offering specific, dated, and witnessed commitments to carry the mission forward effectively.



Second Generation Youth Workshop

The following day, the focus shifted toward investing in the community's youth. A special 1-Day Second Generation Workshop gathered young members aged 11 to 15, centering on three essential themes:

Identity and Leadership: Encouraging youth to understand their unique value and potential as future leaders.

Faith in Daily Life: Providing practical guidance on how personal faith and moral choices apply to everyday scenarios.

Foundations of Blessing: Exploring what it means to build relationships grounded in strong character, mutual care, and intentional preparation.

Rather than presenting these topics as abstract ideals, the workshop offered them as a living inheritance of Heavenly Parent's blessing, guiding participants to see how their daily choices actively shape the world around them.
