

## FFWPU DR Congo: Nearly 800 Gather in Kinshasa for 2026 Youth Summer Camp

Event Theme/Objective: A special service concluding the Month of Renewal and launching the start of the summer camps under the theme "A Filial Heart Toward HOLY MOTHER HAN."

On Sunday, June 28, 2026, 788 members gathered at the National Center of the DRC in Kinshasa for a service marking the conclusion of the Month of Renewal and Fidelity to True Mother, while officially launching the 2026 Edition of the Youth Summer Camp, themed: "A Filial Heart Toward Holy Mother Han."

The celebration began in an atmosphere of joy and gratitude with musical performances and a time of praise led by various choirs. The Second Generation children opened this segment with inspiring songs, followed by the elder's choir, creating an environment conducive to prayer, worship, and fraternal communion.

The main message was delivered by the National Vice-Leader, Reverend Pumsu Tambwe, focusing on the sub-theme: "The Victory of Our True Mother and Our Responsibility."
