CARP Las Vegas held the End-of-the Semester 7 Day Divine Principle Workshop from May 15th to 22nd at Cheon Hwa Gun, filled with True Parents' heart and energy. The End-of-the-Semester workshops give the guests opportunities to study the entire Principle and be introduced to the life course of True Parents, encouraging them to pursue Principle-centered life style. It was the fifth end-of-the-semester DP workshop since CARP LV started.

"Find the Purpose, Change Your Life" was the theme of the workshop. Lectures from Dr. Michael Hentrich were filled with spiritual power, and spoke strongly to the original mind of all participants. Among the 1st Generation participants included 3 new guests who attended the 7-day workshop for the first time and 2 'returning' guests. 6 members from Generation Peace Academy as well as 2 2nd Generation young adults flew in to rediscover DP. CARP Las Vegas core members took loving yet powerful leadership roles in caring for a wide range of the guests. They also organized activities that were fun, but also serious and deeply thought-provoking which helped them to reflect deeply about their lives.



The main objective of this 7-day workshop was to educate these participants about the time we were living in now - that we stood in the position to attend True Parents. After the lectures on the course of Jesus, a special activity was organized to challenge participants physically and mentally, giving them an opportunity to taste a heart and position as a Messianic figure. On a following day, they received True Parents' course at International Peace Education Center (IPEC). Also, they received guidance on prayer and reflection activity inside the True Parents' residence where True Parents used to hold HDH. One of new guests, Jonathan Daza who were spiritually sensitive, shared how he saw pink aura flashing from everything in True Parents' room, and how the pink aura was filled with energy of love.

At the end of the 7 days, all participants shared how God was guiding them to be at the workshop, and how they almost felt transformed during the workshop.
