

## Las Vegas Family Church Peace Road 2017 Hike to the top of Fletcher Peak

It is a 7 mile (11.5 km) hike from the trail head to the top (10,319 feet) and back. We will leave from 7966 Haven St. Las Vegas, at 6:30 am, (so be there by 7:15) and expect to be back by 3 pm. We will car pool as much as possible.

Bring comfortable sport shoes (not brand new), water and whatever food you want. The Temperature will be about 45 degrees on the top and could be windy, so bring something to keep yourself warm.

If you are driving to the Trail head: Take 95 north. 1.5 miles after exit #95 (Skye Canyon Park Drive), turn left on 157 (Kyle Canyon Rd) towards Mt Charleston. After about 17 miles, turn right on Deer Creek Rd (hwy 158) – go 4.9 miles and you will see a parking area on your left, this is the trail head (named – North Loop Trail Head). We plan to meet there at 7:30 am to begin the hike.
