**Objective of Campus Talk:**

Solidifying and expanding the group of students, faculty, and community leaders who are dedicated to practicing and spreading the lifestyle of sexual integrity as a solution to complicated and destructive issues of our society (not just as a religious practice or spiritual discipline) --

Increasing the awareness of life of sexual integrity as a doorway to higher and more fulfilling relationships of lasting love.

**Expected outcome:**

ENCOURAGED/EMPOWERED: Students feel PROUD and ENCOURAGED about their choice to live a life of sexual integrity, or FEEL ENCOURAGED to try this lifestyle. (CB)

CLARITY: Participants have gained conceptual understanding that life of sexual integrity will bring about significant positive impact and consequences to them as well as to our families and community. Understanding that SOCIAL impact of individual sexual choices/life style is significant; and that this values/culture will need to be driving the new society. (Mia)

HOPEFUL - Participants have gained a sense of HOPE that life of sexual integrity (and intact family) can actually make a huge difference and significant impact in our community.

READY TO ACT - Participants feel EXCITED TO SPREAD the message of life of sexual integrity (and intact family) as a solution to the issues our community is facing.
