2) Committee Reports

a) Finance - Steve Pierce

- Steve presented a summary of the period from July to Sept, comparing last year to this year.
- Our savings fell by about half due to support given to the Peace Starts with Me rally and payments to the Architect for the new church building.
- It was suggested that we create a separate category for expenses that are for outreach/evangelical purposes
- Next meeting we will look at the yearly budget for last year, including the monthly averages for income and expenses.

b) Sunday Service - Andy Compton

c) Building - Rev. Doo

- Dieu, the chairperson for the Building Committee gave a report.
- Although the committee has not met for one month, work on the project continues.
- The design and plans for a full size commercial kitchen have been completed
- Now the plans are being made for electrical and plumbing
- Next will be plans for electrical and gas
- The architect will offer suggestions for interior design and AV set-up. When those are submitted the community can make comments and suggestions.

d) Youth and Young Adult - Jonathan Jesper

- The next events will be Pumpkin picking on Oct. 19th and the Halloween Party on Oct 26
- It was suggested that we provide a small stipend for the youth leader. This will be discussed further next month when the budget is decided.
