## VOICE Outline

- 1.) We all know what the fall is, we've heard about it since we were little kids. To some extent I would say we as second generation have become desensitized to it. Its not real and it is not personal.
  - 1. In order to avoid falling we have to do two broad things.
    - 1. First we have to recognize what the fall is and why it is both disgusting and relevant.
    - 2. Secondly we have to learn how to defend ourselves
- 2.) Be able to recognize how the fall is happening all the time
  - 1. The fall is not just sex. Sex is the point of no return on the path of inheriting Satan's culture, it is the absolute perversion of a selfless thing into a selfish thing. The fall is as much a mindset as it is an action.

- 2. The fall of man was when Adam and Eve bought into Satan's culture, and owned it. It became an key part of their identity.
- 3. The fall happens every day, and it always follows a basic outline. A template if you will.
  - 1. Person feels lonely, empty, hated, misunderstood, etc. They are in a state of wanting, needing something in order to feel good.
  - 2. There are two ways to get away from this feeling. One is to indemnify the situation by confronting what caused the problem in the first place and resolving it. The other is to ignore it and do something that brings you joy to help forget about how you feel.
    - 1. Dating is a wonderful example of this. We g out with a person because they make us feel good, entering into a relationship with them because they make us feel better. We don't really care about them, but we are going after the feeling we get by being around them.
  - 3. Eventually we become fixated on this feeling, we become addicts to it. We chase after it, disregarding the needs of others for our own pleasure. We chase a short term happiness and very often manipulate others (parents, friends, partners, etc) in order to get it. This is the starting point of the fall.
- 4. What parts of our culture are results of the fall, which things do we do as a society that reflect Satanic culture? (Make a List)
  - 1. See what things are derived from the fall
  - 2. See how it happens every day
  - 3. See how we have a choice to not do these things
- 2.) Be able to protect yourself from it
  - 1. The best way to avoid falling is to not have give and take with fallen nature.
    - 1. By entering into relationships with things in the fallen culture we give them power over us (we make the choice to let them affect us.)
    - 2. The best way to avoid letting these things influence us is to separate ourselves from these things. So we need to recognize them, then not have give and take with them.
    - 3. <FIND A GAME>
  - 2. The fall is not just one the big action, it is all the little actions
    - 1. The small decisions we make every day in our lives are the ones that dictate how we will act when a big decision comes around.
    - 2. In order to avoid 'falling' the trick isn't to not have sex, but to not make the small choices that lowers our barriers and opens ourselves up for the fall to take place.

  - 3. Have at least two of these three: Faith, Truth, and Community
    - 1. Our spirits are made of three broad areas: emotion, intellect, and will. In order to be what we consider a perfect person each of these three areas needs to be fully matured.
    - 2. Funnily enough, temptation comes from these three areas. When we are tempted away from the correct path the temptation comes from either faith, understanding, or friends.

- 1. Faith: Trust that overpowers knowledge or lack thereof
- 2. Truth (Understanding): Understanding and Knowledge
- 3. Community (Friends): A place where you feel acceptance and love
- 3. So in order to avoid falling you must have faith in the right things, an understanding of how things really work, and a place where you can find support and love to keep doing the things that faith and truth guide you to do. (Purpose of UPN is to give these three things:)
