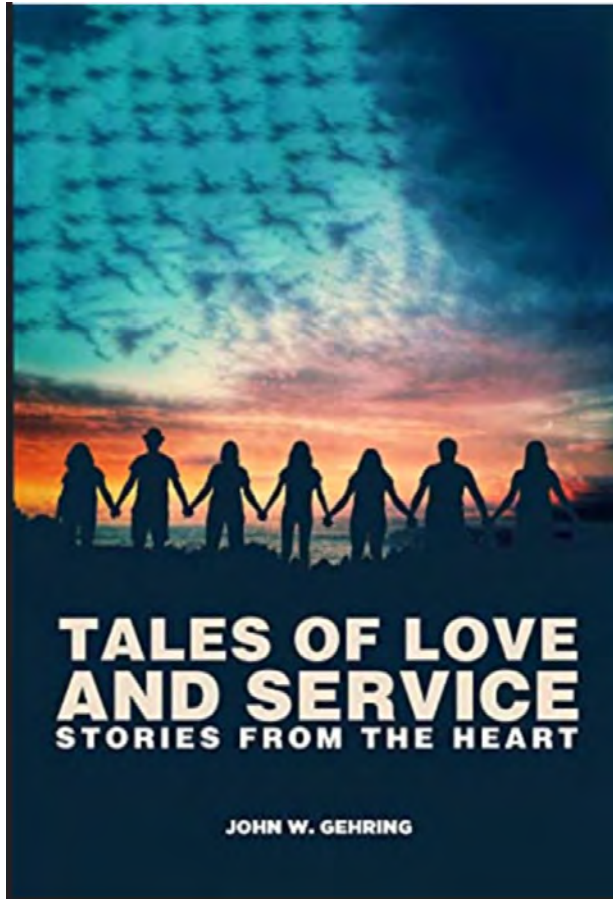


UPF New York Tales of Love and Service: Stories from the Heart, by John W. Gehring
