Dear Blessed Families,

We would like to invite all parents who have children of matching age, or who are approaching matching age, to attend an upcoming European Parents Matching Convocation. **Parents of Blessed Children** and **Parents of Jacob Children** are welcome to attend. (Please note: there will be a separate Matching and Blessing Preparation Workshop specifically for Second Generation and Jacob Children who are at least 24 years old, and their parents, scheduled for 8-11 December this year. This October convocation is only for parents.)

At this weekend you will receive practical information as well as valuable internal guidance; this will be helpful whether you are preparing to match your children in the future or are already in the process of doing so. Those working as matching supporters will be available to talk with you and help you make a matching plan for your child.

The European Parents Matching Convocation will take place at: **Seminarhaus Neumühle**, (near Bad Camberg), Germany. From **Friday**, **7**th **to Sunday**, **9**th **October 2016**.

The purpose of the convocation is to support parents in the task of matching their children. True Parents have passed this responsibility over to parents in blessed families, and as the era of Cheon II Guk matching (True Parents' Matching) has now passed, it is our task to take this precious work forward based on all the extraordinary work True Parents have done in this area until now. Although the responsibility for matching lies specifically with parents, the support we can give is part of our community-level responsibility and the sharing of our experiences, and even our difficulties, is all part of setting a tradition that will be carried on into the future. The Convocation will include education and guidance on issues relating to the matching and Blessing, including the "Treasures of Heaven" ministry for blessed children with special needs. There will be time set aside to meet and share with other Blessed Families, an aspect that people find so valuable.

Display of Candidates' Profiles

The Convocation setting also provides an opportunity to display photographs and information about your child if he/she is a matching candidate, and to see the pictures and personal details about other matching candidates from all over Europe, and even from other parts of the world. This may directly help the process of finding a suitable partner for your child.

It is recommended that you register early. There are limited spaces available and these will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

Please consider whether you would like to display your child's profile at the convocation. If you would like to do so, please inform us by email at <u>pmc@ esgd.org</u> (deadline: 30 September). Note that we will only display profiles of candidates who have explicitly expressed their wish to have them displayed. Profiles will not be displayed by us unless you specifically inform us that you would like us to do so. Please note that it is possible to display the profile of your child even though you do not attend the Convocation in person.

To ensure that your profile is displayed you have several options:

- If your child is already registered on the International Matching website <u>www,bcmatching,org</u> make sure the profile is updated and inform us that you want to display his/her profile. We can then print your profile from the website and display it. (If you are not registered, you can use this opportunity to register your child on the website. This not only allows you to use the website, but also means that you only have to update your profile, and it can then be displayed at any future convocation, in Europe or elsewhere, just by notifying us.)
- 2. If you submitted a Blessing Application, we can also use copies of your Blessing Application (Pictures, Application form and Family Introduction form) to display the profile.
- 3. If neither of the above applies, you can still hand in your own materials: pictures, letters or other information for display. Contact information and basic data (name, date of birth, etc.) should be included. We enclose a profile form that you can use to fill in this information and send to us at pmc@ esgd.org

Furthermore, it is particularly helpful if the candidate can fill out the attached questionnaire below and send it to us.

Please send **all information** to us at least one week before the date of the event (30 September), so that we have to time to collate and prepare copies.
