## **Soup Kitchens Fighting Frontline Starvation**

We wanted to share a powerful and urgent update from our work on the ground. Our latest blog post tells the story of the crisis in Walmer Township, Nelson Mandela Bay, South Africa — where children are quietly starving while local heroes fight every day to stop that from happening.

"Children are dying – quietly, in hospitals, in townships, in homes..."

In the past year, more than 25 children under five have died from severe acute malnutrition — and the number continues to rise.



In the midst of this crisis, IRFF UK is supporting a lifeline: a soup kitchen run by the Walmer Angel Project, serving around 500 meals 5 times a week to those who would otherwise go

# Soup kitchens fight frontline starvation

The reports are devastating - more than two dozen children starved to death in South Africa's Eastern Cape province over the past year.

"Children are dying – quietly, in hospitals, in townships, in homes," reported *Daily Maverick Baywatch* in late July.

This is happening in one of South Africa's most prosperous metros – Nelson Mandela Bay – named in honour of the former president and humanitarian.

Twenty-five children under the age of five died from severe acute malnutrition in the past year, according to state institutions and media reports. Hundreds more are starving. Diagnoses of malnutrition have surged, and child deaths have nearly doubled since 2023.





Two years ago, the South African Human Rights Commission called the situation a disaster and urged the government to declare a state of emergency.

Nothing has been done.

Yet just a short distance away, an IRFF-supported soup kitchen is providing a lifelinein the poverty-stricken Walmer Township in Port Elizabeth.

But it's not nearly enough.

The soup kitchen is one of four run by the Walmer Angel Project which currently feeds around 2,000 people. Every weekday, volunteers cook and serve hot, nutritious meals – mostly to children and the elderly. In a community where unemployment is high and many families live in overcrowded shacks, these soup kitchens are often the only source of food for the day.



"There is so much unemployment in the township, so we do what we can to alleviate many unbearable situations," says Glenda Brunette, founder of the Walmer Angel Project.



"It breaks our hearts to see people in this community going hungry," wrote Cecilia Adams in a message to IRFF UK.

"Any contribution, no matter how small, would make a significant difference in our ability to continue providing meals."





IRFF UK currently sends £200 a month to support the kitchen that feeds 500 mouths.




