Fundraiser for Second Gen in Africa



Unja Nnode is the second generation son of Stephan Ngalame's spiritual son, George Nnode, in Cameroon, West Africa. George is the lecturer and organizer of numerous Divine Principle workshop all over Cameroon.

His son, Unja, 24 years old, has dedicated three years to the missions program and is very active in church and UPF activities in Cameroon. He is the first person to be called upon to support church activities in West Africa. Unja has already earned his bachelor's degree in Computer Science at the University in Yaoundé, Cameroon. However, there are few opportunities for further education or employment in Cameroon.

He twice was offered a full scholarship to Sun Moon University, but despite fulfilling all requirements he was refused a visa from the Korean Embassy. It is very difficult for Cameroonians to be granted a visa. Recently, he was accepted by the Japanese Language Institute Cameroon, which recruits students to study in Japanese universities. The school handles the visa applications, so if he is accepted to a Japanese university, there will be no further obstacles, except paying the fees and tuition. Once Unja is in Japan, he will be able to support himself by working part-time.

Unja wants to study abroad to increase his knowledge and experience and also to be able to earn money to support the family back home. Stephan Ngalame has been supporting the family for years because the situation is such that they have a difficult time even with basic needs. His ultimate goal is to return to Cameroon and to serve the nation of his birth, contributing to its development in the future. Please join in supporting this capable and motivated young man who, struggling to overcome obstacles for the past two years, is finally in a position today where a door is opening for him. Please help him to walk through that door.

- Find space for meaningful discussions, connection, and renewal

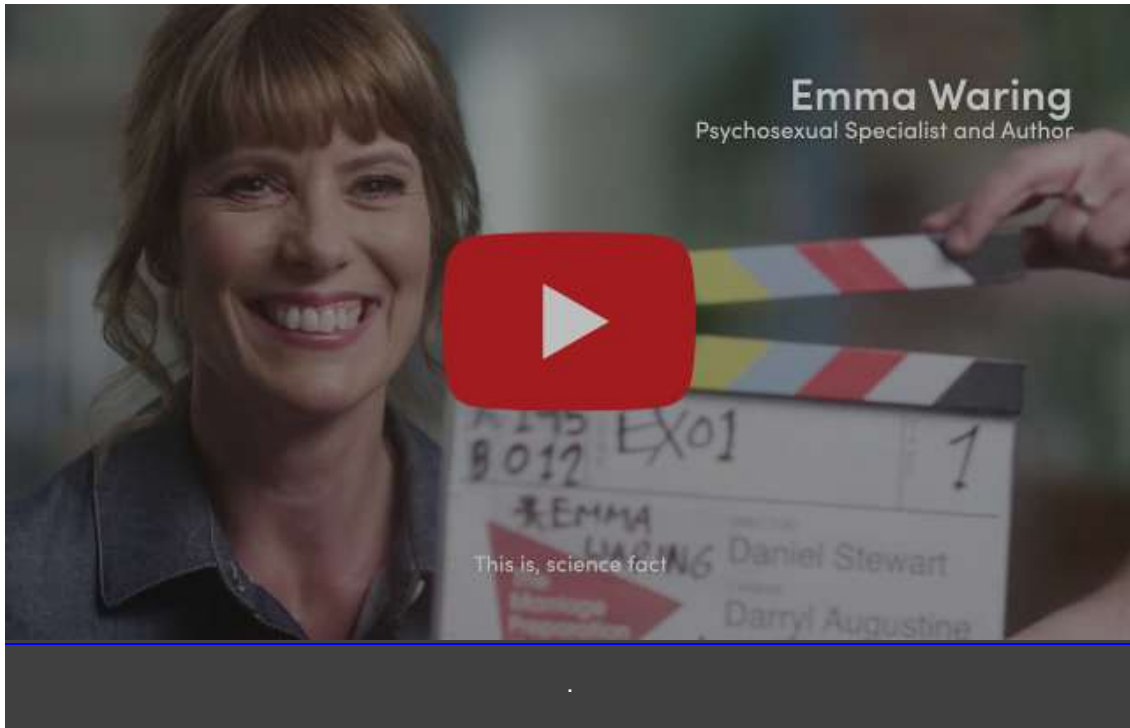

Saturday Cheon Shim Won Prayer Vigil



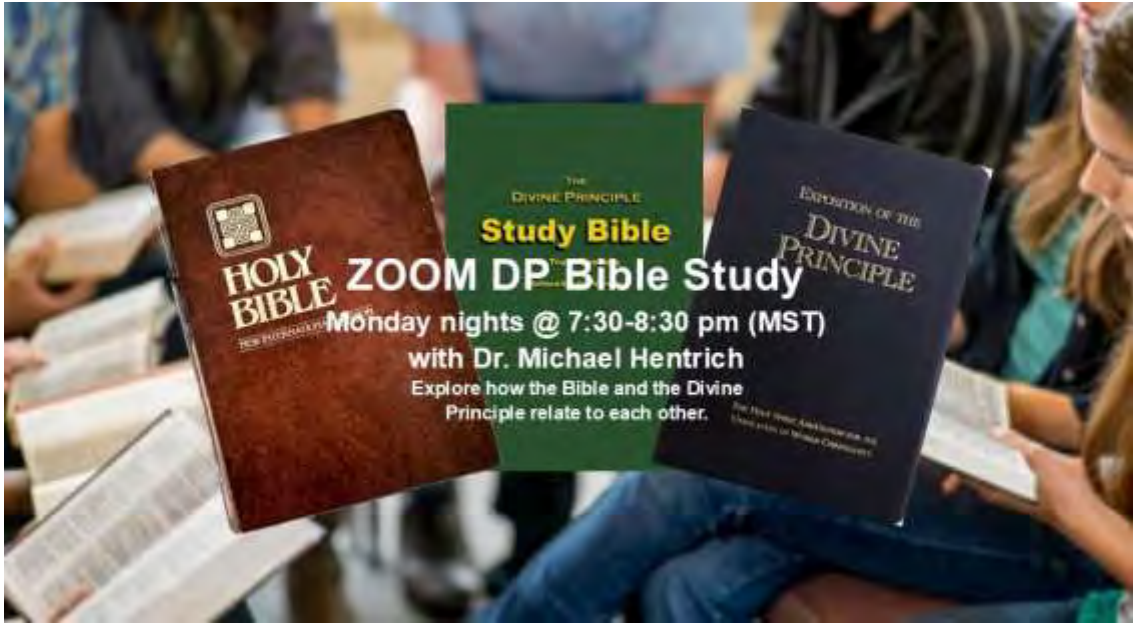
