Registration is open for 2026 Family Camp! We've reserved the Waunita Hot Springs Ranch, a 250 acre ranch close to Gunnison with an Olympic size geothermal pool with enough space to fit our entire group. They have the capacity for about 65 people.

We will be there from the afternoon of Friday, July 10th to the morning of Monday, the 13th. We are excited to be able to take time together as families in nature, come closer as a community, and also we are planning a spiritual component as well. As in previous years, the church has subsidized half of the cost, and we only ask families to pay \$100 per person up to a maximum of \$400 per nuclear family. Children under 2 are free. We love for multigenerational families to come, but we must ask that you register and pay separately to maintain the affordability of the camp. Please come prepared to help with meals and cleaning from time to time.

Space is limited. Please register online and don't delay, as it is first come first-served. Once we get close to our registration capacity, we will close registration and create a standby list. We hope that everyone that wishes to go to Family Camp this year will be able to attend.
