We were grateful to receive four visitors from CARP Los Angeles who shared with us on Wednesday evening and also supported our campus witnessing activities.


Summer Pastoral Internship

The Akamine family has been spending the last two months in our community. They've made this very heart-warming video of their time here, really appreciating our community. Please take a look.



