Dear family,

We are excited to finally open registration for the 2023 Family Camp! Once again, we've reserved the Waunita Hot Springs Ranch, a 250 acre ranch with an Olympic size geothermal pool with enough space to fit our entire group and a 5-star Google Maps rating. They have the capacity for about 65 people.

We will be there from the afternoon of Friday, July 28 to the morning of Monday, the 31st. We are excited to be able to take time together as families in nature, come closer as a community, and also we are planning a spiritual component as well. Individuals are welcome to come as well, but please be prepared to share a room with someone.

As in previous years, the church has subsidized half of the cost, and we only ask families to pay \$75 per person up to a maximum of \$300 per nuclear family. Children under 2 are free. We love for multigenerational families to come, but we must ask that you register and pay separately to maintain the affordability of the camp.

Space is limited. Please register online and don't delay, as it is first come first-served.

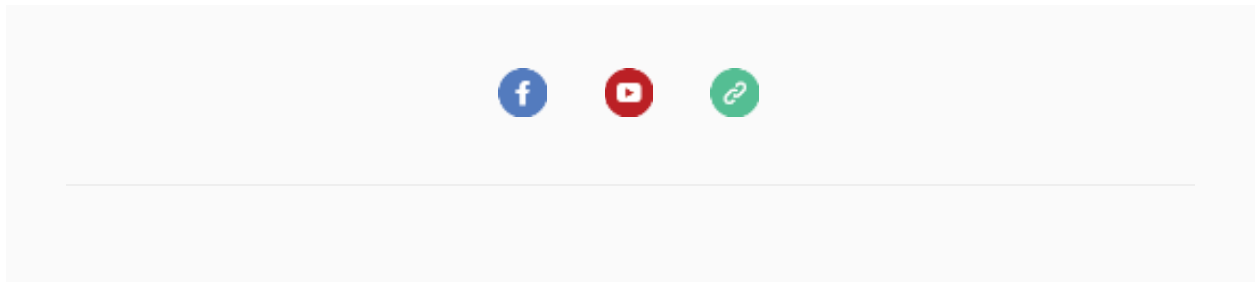

2023 Family Camp Registration

We are super excited to be able to hold our annual family camp at the Waunita Hot Springs Ranch (near Gunnison, CO) again this year. The dates will be from Friday afternoon, July 28 to the morning of Monday, the 31st. Registration will be first come, first serve. You can get a feeling for the camp experience by watching last year's video below.

The registration cost is \$75 per person, capped at \$300 per nuclear family. This cost includes food and lodging for 3 nights. It does not include some extracurricular activities that may be available, such as horse riding. In order to obtain this price, the church is subsidizing 50% of the cost of the camp, and we will be working together to prepare our own meals. We love for multigenerational families to come, but we must ask that you register and pay separately to maintain the affordability of the camp.
