We are now almost six months in the making, and if you have free phone calling to America you can join our free conference call every day. We are determined to bring together thousands of our members for continuous prayer, united as one family to bring revival to our movement, unite with Mother's direction and bring an end to the divisiveness and negativity that still pervades on internet and in the hearts of our members and the True Children.
