



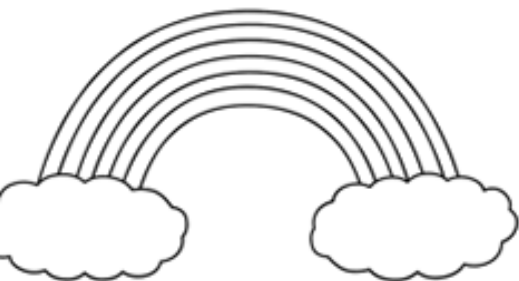

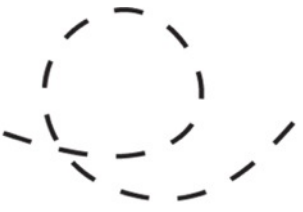

'This past week has been magical. It's been a process of healing hearts, of encouraging minds'





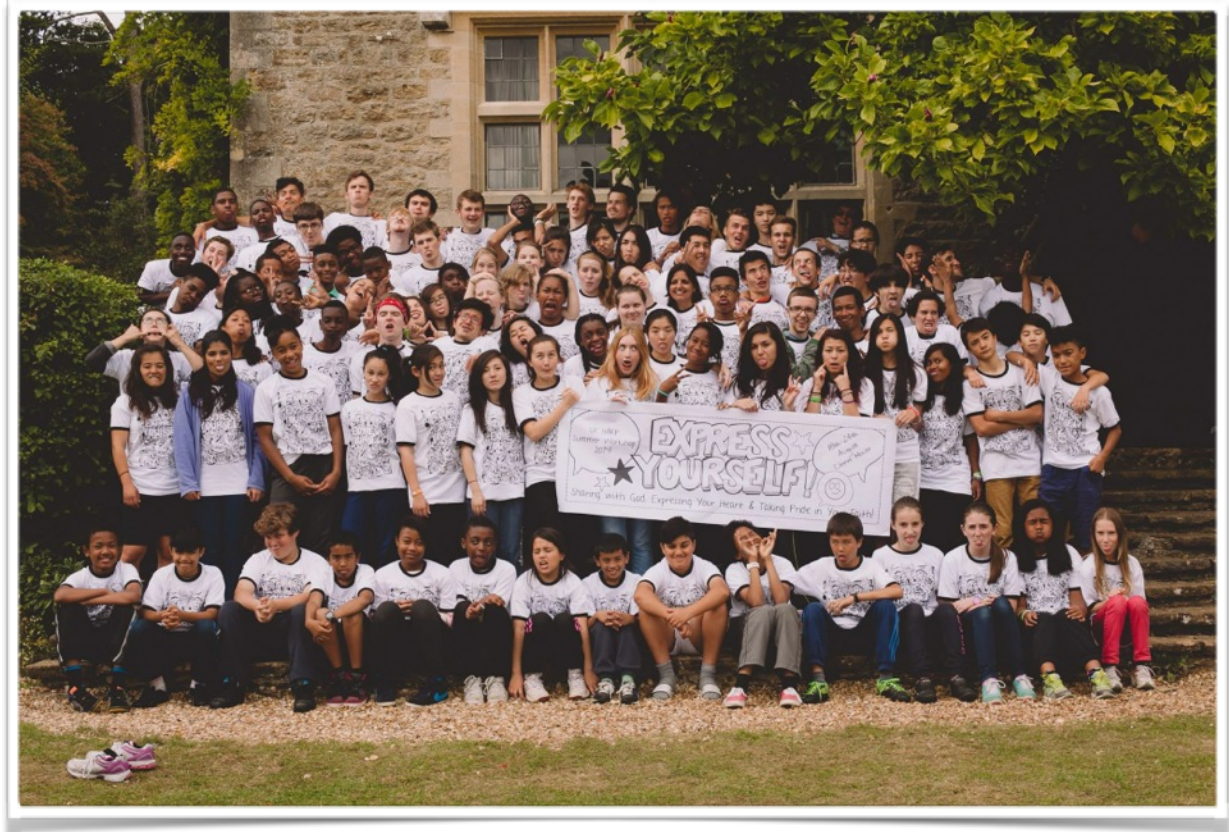
