When I was in Minnesota two weeks ago for the [groundbreaking ceremony for the new church](#), I was very inspired to see the unity between the co-pastors and between the pastors and the family members. I have seen and felt True Parents' love and heart from each one of you. I am also very proud of your teamwork between younger and elder Unificationists for Vision 2020 and the new church building. I was the regional leader in Minnesota twice, in 1986 and in 1990. My family and I still talk about the many good memories we have because of your beautiful hearts. At that time, almost 20 years ago, the Minnesota community and I purchased the sorority house on campus as a new church.
