## Heung Jin Nim (in the spiritual world): The victory of love can only emerge, if love is unconditional

Dear brothers and sisters!

Here again some inspiration, based on the words of True Father, True Mother and Heung Jin Nim (in the spiritual world):

True Father: "Real love is not giving and keeping account of how much was given. It is not self-serving. Real love exists for the sake of others. After having loved someone, can you say, "The reason I loved you was so I could be happy"? You must not go there.

The person who feels inadequate after having loved, the person who feels many things even beyond inadequacy, is in accord with the principle of ideal love. But the person who says, "Now that I have loved you, you have to love me," is not in accord with this principle." [1]

Real love, true love, God's love, is unconditional. It gives without expecting anything in return. It gives to friends, and it gives to enemies. It embraces friends, and it embraces enemies, limitlessly. It forgives friends, and it forgives enemies, also limitlessly. This "limitlessly" is so important. Because if our love stops at some point, it is not real love. It is not love that resonates with God's and True Parents' love. It is not selfless. God's and True Parents' love never stops:

True Father: "Everything that has to do with human circumstances and recognition in the world comes to an end. Yet eternal true love never comes to an end, no matter how much you give out. Amazingly, it continues eternally. Therefore with the power of love you can move the entire universe and still have more remaining." [2]

True Mother: "Love within limits is not true love. True love is always new, yet is unchanging. Circumstances and environments change, but true love remains. It does not grow old or stale. It is ever fresh, in spring, in summer, in autumn and winter, in your youth, your adulthood and your old age." [3]

Why can true love go on forever? Because it does not expect a reward. If nothing comes back in return, true love is not frustrated. It simply keeps loving, no matter what. It never gives up, it never ends:

Heung Jin Nim: "Unconditional love never ends....The victory of love can only emerge, if love is unconditional." [4]

How do we develop our love to the level of God's and True Parents' love? From where do we get the capacity to forgive our enemies over and over again, just as True Father forgave the Japanese policeman Kamada Hara, who had tortured him?

True Mother: "The capacity to forgive your enemy and save his or her life does not appear overnight. It requires that we eliminate the resentment and anger in our hearts and see the countenance of God in the face of our enemy. Father Moon could do so because he did not think of Mr. Hara as his enemy. Even while being tortured, he prayed for him and forgave him." [5]

God sees in everyone His beloved child, no matter how evil that person may be. We need to get in line with such a way of thinking. We need to understand God and align with His parental viewpoint. We cannot hate people that God loves and tries to save. And we need to ask God to help us with all this. That will very much deepen our relationship with Him. And it will help us to develop a love on the level of God's love. It will help us to make our love unchanging and unconditional. It will bring our love to fruition, make it flourish:

True Mother: "When we give and forget, true love flourishes. We do not run out of love by giving it away. Quite the opposite. True love is a spring that flows in ever greater abundance. When walking the path of love, even when you give something precious, you feel that you did not give enough. Living with true love does not make one prideful. If anything, one feels sorry for not being able to give something even better." [6]

The more our love is in line with God's love, the more God and the universe support and protect us, and the more God can work through us. And our love is in line with God as long as we do not expect anything in return. If we nurture that attitude, then we can go on forever. Our love becomes unchanging and eternal, just as the love of God and True Parents. And the more we love, the more we receive:

True Mother: "The fallen world programs us to think that when we give something away, it is gone. In true love, however, the more we give, the more we receive. When our mindset changes from wishing to receive love, to wishing to give love, the world of peace will be at hand." [7]

And the more people live according to this logic of love, the faster God's Kingdom will be established:

True Father: "Everything can be burned up or washed away but because of you, there is a seed of hope on the earth. This seed will perpetuate and become like a tremendous vine, growing forever and ever. No power exists which can stop this hope. The roots of a tree can penetrate even a huge rock; in exactly the same way, the power of love will grow and take root over the whole earth." [8]
