Here again some inspiration, based on the words of True Father and True Mother:

True Father: "Everything in a person's life should be done for the sake of true love." [1]

How can we do "everything" for the sake of love? That may sound quite puzzling for some.

Living for the sake of true love, however, is not so much a matter of what we externally do or not do. It is rather a matter of attitude that we have towards God and the people that come across our way. It is a matter of heart and attitude.

What kind of heart is needed here? A heart that wants the ideal world to be established soon. A heart that wants to contribute to that, by striving to practice a love that is in line with the way God loves. Our love needs to become true. That means it must become God-like love.

It is respectful, never puts people down. It never judges or accuses, but rather embraces. It never stops, it never calculates. It never counts. It expects nothing. After every encounter with people, no matter who that is, we can analyze ourselves if we have made enough heartistic effort. Our heart will tell us if we could have done more. And then, next time, we can try to make it better. That way we grow constantly.

The more we manage to develop a heart where investing love into people becomes the most important

thing for us every day, the more we become God-like, inheriting God's heart. Then, what we do externally, is secondary.

Developing a God-like heart does not require additional time. It rather saves time, because the more we love people the less conflict we have with them, and that means we do not waste time and nerves with struggles and conflicts. Developing a God-like heart is the biggest problem solver:

True Father: "When your standard of heart is the same as God's, all problems will be solved." [6]

True Father: "With the love of God, the more you give, the more you receive. You become a giant. The more you give the more you receive, not only from God but also from people; your one investment derives benefit from both ends." [2]

True Father: "Anyone who can love their enemy -- whether individual, race, or nation -- will inherit from God any resources he needs." [4]

As we strive to raise the level of our heart and love every day, without ceasing, we come to experience what True Father is mentioning here. Gradually we will experience it more and more. We will see God's mighty hand moving in our life:

True Father: "Once you reach the divine mind within you and come back out to the world, you will find that God is already before you; thus nothing will be able to disconnect you or overcome you." [5]

The divine mind is the mind of true love, that loves the way God does. We are all able to reach it. If we think that this is too much or too difficult for us, then we might not even start on this path, or turn back after a short time.

Basically a life of true love is a blessed life. It is more blessed than any other life style. The more we progress on this path, the more joy and happiness we will experience. Nothing will be able to stop us.
