

True Father: Let us be a true parent, true teacher and true owner, as God is!

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Anyonghaseyo, dear brothers and sisters!

Here again some inspiration, based on the words of True Father and True Mother:

True Mother: "The most important thing is that you always live a life of truly loving the people you are dealing with. Although it is important to use one's intelligence in life, I want to beg you today to use your heart more."

The ideal world is the world of heart and love. Such a world can only be established by the power of true love:

True Father: "...let us sweep away the absurdities and evils of this world through the power of God's true love." [1]

Using our heart means to practice true love. True love is not just an emotion or some nice feeling. True love is an attitude. It has to be developed, trained, in many situations, all the time. True love is a conscious investment into people, into all the people we come in contact with.

True love invests without expecting a return. It does not wait to receive, but just invests. And if nothing comes back, that does not stop true love from continuing to invest. True love keeps investing, no matter what the response may be. True love invests for the sake of the other person, no matter who or how that other person is:

True Mother: "Love is not just loving somebody who is easy to love, but enduring, forgiving, and embracing people in order to fulfill the providence. Father is now showing us this kind of love."

Indeed, true love moves the providence. It is that powerful. Actually not only True Parents should demonstrate such a quality of love. We all should become true parents and true teachers:

True Father: "In conclusion, let us be a true parent, true teacher and true owner, as God is." [2]

Indeed, our heart needs to reach the level of God's heart. That is our destiny. And, of course, we have the potential.

But this potential needs to be activated. And that goes only by practicing true love in daily life. Here we encounter many situations where we can either break down limitations of heart and raise the level of our love, or we can follow fallen patterns, which results in stagnation of heart.

For example: We all know situations where people agitate us a lot, often beyond our limits. Our first impulse is probably to try to put them straight. Trying this, we easily enter into conflict. Love is being replaced by resentment, if not hatred.

We can either follow such old patterns, with which we are quite familiar, or we can rise above them by ignoring the wrong attitude or behaviour of the other person, and focus on investing heart and love. That way we break down limitations of our heart.

Then our heart becomes more and more loving, more and more parental. True love becomes more and more our nature. Less and less we fall back into fallen patterns, fallen mindset. We can see ourselves growing all the time, becoming more and more able to relate to all kinds of people that we could not well relate to in the past. And we will not worry if we should forgive someone or not. Because we just keep loving. Forgiveness is included in that.

As we break down the limitations of our heart, we get closer and closer to "Heaven":

True Father: "What is heaven? Heaven starts by loving another human being the way God does." [3]

And that does not only apply to ONE person, but to all people we meet. Investing heart and love into people that are difficult to love is the fastest way to become God-like, in terms of love. It is the fastest way to create heaven in our heart, and in the world. It is the fastest way to mobilize God in our life and to attract His blessing:

True Father: "When you become a person who creates a heartistic relation even with your enemies you can restore history and be resurrected." [4]

Those who walk that road are highly blessed indeed.
