True Father: An original person is not someone who tries to receive love from others

Anyonghaseyo, dear brothers and sisters!

Here again some inspiration based on the words of True Father and True Mother:

True Father: "Instead of seeking love for our own sake, we need to love others for their sake, making them masters of love... Thus, we can become God's heirs, people who know God and beautify and protect His kingdom. Satan will have no way to interfere with the heirs of God. If you love your enemies, transcending your anger and hatred... you will gain dominion over the world of enemies, and Satan will retreat." [1]

In the fallen world people are focused on getting love, attention and respect from others. That way they cannot love others and cannot grow in heart. All this leads to fighting and struggle. But people cannot image a different way. For them the selfish way seems normal. Unselfish love seems foolish. Loving the enemy seems unthinkable.

Our focus, however, should be to give love to others, unconditionally, unchangingly. We should be the ones who love everyone with unconditional love, even those that oppose us:

True Father: "You are not to be people who just receive love and long for love within the Unification

Church. The focal point of our activities is loving humanity and loving God." [2]

By just trying to FIND love we cannot establish God's Kingdom. Our focus must be to GIVE love without expecting a return. Then we ourselves grow, and through our heart and love we have a positive influence on others. We ourselves become masters of love, and we can inspire others to walk the same path of love:

True Mother: "Throughout his life, Jesus never said he wanted to receive love. Rather he said he came to serve, and that he would love even his enemies.

Without that kind of love, we cannot find the origin of peace; and without the origin of peace, we cannot establish a world of peace. The world of peace can never come to exist as long as we focus only on receiving love. "[3]

Therefore, our focus must be giving instead of receiving love. All mankind has to make that shift. Otherwise the ideal world cannot come, the world where everyone is investing heart and love unconditionally into others.

We all have to become original people, in the image of God, who receive joy and intoxication by loving the way God does:

True Father: "An original person is not someone who tries to receive love from others. Nor does this person try to receive God's love. He or she is someone who already lives intoxicated in God's love." [4]

This satisfaction and intoxication in God's love occurs as we make constant and conscious effort to focus on loving the way God does, on being a blessing to others, on understanding and uplifting others, without expecting anything in return. By just trying to RECEIVE love we will not get very far. We will be stagnating in heart, not becoming happy people, not being able to contribute very much to the establishment of God's Kingdom.

It stands to reason that we constantly practice a love that is focused on giving instead of receiving. This should become our habit, our nature. This way we become divine sons and daughters of God.
