

Presentation about the Universal Peace Academy

Prague, the Czech Republic, 13. August 2013

On the 13th August 2013 some 16 people came to attend the presentation of the Universal Peace Academy which was at the Prague HQ.

The second generation sister Jana Lajdová as the only representative from Europe who is studying there showed the UPA video and her own presentation about the life, purpose and goals of the UPA.
