

Ancestor Liberation Ceremony for Generations 1-430 and Cheonshim Won Prayer

Ancestor Liberation Ceremonies for Generations 1-430 were held on the first and second days of the Great Works (Oct. 24 and 25) with a total of 10,784 people attending (Ancestor Liberation: 7,911, Collateral Liberation: 2,873). A 30-minute chanyang session for Ancestor Liberation was held after the opening ceremony from 2:20 p.m., followed by a Cheonshim Won prayer. All the participants offered prayers expressing their sincere wishes and strong desire to become spiritually reborn with new minds and bodies and become one with heaven. The first day's Ancestor Liberation Ceremony and pre-recorded Cheonshim Won prayer were edited and aired from 8:50 a.m. on the second day, and all senior staff and employees of the training center attended the chanyang session for Ancestor Liberation and a Cheonshim Won prayer, offering prayers with their sincere hearts that the grace of CheonBo Works would spread to those participating in sites throughout Japan and around the world.
