

HJ CB Engagement and Blessing Ceremony for Ascended Unmarried Spirits

On 11.6 by the heavenly calendar in the 8th year of Cheon Il Guk (December 20, 2020), the 1520th Hyojeong CheonBo Workshop was held in the main and small halls of the Cheonseong Wanglim Palace.

The workshop was conducted using an online platform to stream the program to local churches and training centers around the world. About 10 members of the training center staff attended off-line, offering sincere jeongseong while conforming carefully to COVID-19 social distancing protocols.



A total of 30,254 people registered for the workshop. The special feature of this month's workshop was an Engagement Ceremony and Blessing Ceremony for Ascended 2nd and 3rd Generation Unmarried Spirits with a total of 52 couples participating (12 in Korea, 18 in Japan, 22 international). The parents of the spirit world brides and grooms participated in local churches, joining the broadcast program at their local churches.

The afternoon schedule started at 1:15 p.m. with opening announcements, followed by a holy song,

gyeongbae, family pledge, report prayer, and a Hyojeong Today news video, and was hosted by Korean Workshop Team Leader Ju-hwan Kim.



After the opening ceremony finished, President Gi-seong Lee delivered an opening message. Then, the chanyang session for the Ancestor Liberation Ceremony, Cheonshim Won prayer and the Ancestor Blessing Ceremony followed, and the entire event was concluded with the closing announcement at 5:00 p.m. All portions of the program were broadcast live using recorded video and simultaneous Japanese and English interpretation.



The Blessing Ceremony that was part of Hyojeong CheonBo Special Workshop 1520 included Ancestors in generations 1–430 of the paternal line, maternal line, father's maternal line, and mother's maternal line, along with a Blessing Ceremony for Ascended 2nd and 3rd Generation Unmarried Spirits at the small hall. Promotion Department Director Jong-jin Kim led the service, which included the following main elements: invocation (Vice President Myong-kwan Lee), officiator's message (President Gi-seong Lee and his wife), Blessing ceremony, and benediction prayer.
