1. Name

3. Identify the issue you wish to address in your community/society

Please provide a clear description of the issue you wish to address in your project – a more detailed outline of your issue will help to focus your project and attract potential collaborators.

4. Proposed project

Provide a brief summary of your proposed project or initial idea. To the best of your ability, outline your:

- *main aims (what do you intend on achieving?)*
- *methods/program of events (what will the project be?)*
- *collaborator profile (what kind of person could contribute to the project?)*
- *evaluation and follow-up (how will you measure the impact of your project and sustain the outcomes?)*

5. Budget (if applying for funding)
