

Russian Ambassador for Peace who is bicycling around the world visits London

London, United Kingdom -- A Russian Ambassador for Peace who is bicycling around the world stopped by the UPF offices in London.

Ildus Yanyshv began his journey in April from his hometown of Kazan, the capital of the Russian Republic of Tatarstan. His "Global Bike Tour of Peace and Goodwill" will cover 25,000 kilometers (more than 15,534 miles) in support of the UPF "Peace Road" project. On different sections of the road, other cyclists who support the concept of bicycling for peace have made plans to join him.
