UPF United Kingdom: Peace Advocates in UK Elaborate on a Culture of Peace

He was followed by a number of wide-ranging, thought-provoking speeches from peace advocates and community leaders. Among them were **Ms. Hilde Rapp**, co-director at the Centre for International Peacebuilding London; **Mr. Timothy John Baptiste**, founder of Time 4 Peace; and **Ms. Lorna Marah**, founder and CEO of Rhynie Consulting.



There were also several speeches from ambassadors for peace, including **Mr. Aurangzeb Akbar.** It was a great opportunity to connect with like-minded individuals dedicated to promoting peace, understanding, and hope in a world facing challenges of division and conflict.

The International Day of Peace was also commemorated in Birmingham and South London together with the Women's Federation for World Peace (WFWP), an organization affiliated with UPF.
