In addition, we discussed the need for a BFC Young Adult Pastor, and formed an "ad hoc" committee to explore this. We also decided to develop "ad hoc" committees for additional BFC needs, such as member care and effective volunteering. There will be more on this in future updates.

Our meeting concluded with a respectful "closing round", with each person sharing their views on the meeting and ideas for improving future meetings. People seemed overall enthusiastic and energized about all that was discussed and planned.
